The development of a softball/little league ball field took a giant step forward on June 13<sup>th</sup>, when the city was notified by the MN Twins Community Fund that we were awarded a 2017 Twins Fields for Kids matching grant of \$5000. Councilman Joe Boeringa is working on getting bids for the project. Construction will start as soon as possible.
