Pet License

It's time again to license your dogs and cats. 2015 licenses can be purchased from the city clerk (\$5.00 for dogs, \$3.00 for cats) and are good for one year (Jan. 1 to Dec.31). Proof of vaccinations are required to get your license.

Snow Removal Rules

Even though it has not been snowing, here are the snow removal rules one more time! Whenever we get 2" or more of snow, a "Snow Emergency" is automatically called and **NO** motor vehicle may be parked on the street until the snow is plowed. Your vehicle may be ticketed and towed **at your expense**. House guests and renters need to be made aware of these rules.
