Coronavirus Update

City Hall is open by appointment. Please call anytime with questions or to schedule a time should you need in person assistance. Water bill payments can be placed in the drop box just outside the clerk's office or mailed to the city PO box.

As a reminder, everyone entering city hall for appointments or attending Planning Commission or City Council Meetings will be required to wear a mask. We will continue to have spaced seating in the council chambers and may need to limit the number of individuals in the room at one time.

The Onamia Police Officers and Firefighters received their first Coronavirus vaccinations in January. Other staff will receive them when they become available.

Onamia City Parks are still open. The Ice Skating Rink is open anytime. Skates are available during supervised times: Tuesday, Thurs & Fri. 3-6pm, Saturday 2-6pm and Sunday 12noon-6pm. The warming house will not be open due to the pandemic. Please follow social distancing guidelines when using the parks. Wear a mask when other people who do not live with you are close. Pet License

It's time again to license your dogs and cats. 2021 licenses can be purchased at city hall (\$5.00 for dogs, \$3.00 for cats) and are good for one year (Jan. 1 to Dec.31). Proof of vaccinations is required

to get your license. Due to the pandemic, please call ahead to schedule a time to purchase the license. Remember to wear your mask.

Snow Removal Rules

With all the snow flurries flying around, here are the Snow Removal Rules one more time. Whenever we get 2" or more of snow, a "Snow Emergency" is automatically called and ***NO motor vehicle may be parked on the street until the snow is plowed.*** Your vehicle may be ticketed and towed **at your expense.** House guests and renters need to be made aware of these rules.
